This means trousers or long skirts and tops that cover your shoulders. It also means nothing see-through.
 <p>Grand Palace</p>	8:30 - 15:30 hrs	<p>Phra Borom Maha Ratchawang</p> <p>How to get there Mrt Sanam Chai exit 1 and walk from station 15 minutes</p>	Men must wear long pants; women must cover legs to just above the knee. Avoid wearing tight-fitting stretch pants or "revealing" clothing. Don't wear sleeveless shirts or show shoulders. Don't wear shirts with religious themes or symbols of death (heavy metal t-shirts)
 <p>Erawan Shrine</p>	06:00 – 00:00 hrs	<p>Opposite the Central World</p> <p>How to get there: Walking Distance BTS Siam or BTS Chidlom</p>	There is no strict Dress Code
 <p>Wat Saket (Phu Khao Thong)</p>	7:00 - 19:00 hrs	<p>Boripat Road, Khwaeng Ban Bat, Khet Pom Prap Sattru Phai</p> <p>How to get there: Mrt Sam Yot and walk 16 minutes</p>	For women, cover the shoulders and chest area and wear bottoms that go past the knees. For men, long pants and shirts with sleeves are required. Visitors need to take off their shoes and leave them on the shelves outside before entering any of the religious buildings.
 <p>Pathumwanaram Temple</p>	09:00 – 16:00 hrs	<p>Between Siam Paragon and Central World</p> <p>How to get there: Walking Distance</p> <p>BTS Siam</p>	Make sure your shoulders are covered (no vests, tank tops or spaghetti straps) and although skirts or shorts are acceptable at many temples, they should be smart and at least knee-length

# PEACE AND NATURE BANGKOK

Lumpini Park is Bangkok's most famous park. One of the most extensive greens in the city with its shady trees, scenic lake, and paths for jogging or cycling, it's the perfect place to relax or enjoy outdoor activities.

Here's what you need to know:

- **Opening Hours:** 4:30 AM – 9:00 PM
- **Address:** Rama IV Rd, Pathum Wan, Bangkok
- **Dress Code:** No strict dress code, but wear light, breathable clothes to stay cool in the heat.

How to get there:

Take the BTS Skytrain to Sala Daeng Station (Silom Line) or the MRT Subway to Lumpini Station—both are just a short walk from the park.

Benjakiti Park is a local favorite, offering stunning views of Bangkok's skyscrapers, a beautiful lake, and great running paths. It's the perfect place to relax, take in the scenery, or explore its pet-friendly areas and cozy chill-out spots.

Here's what you need to know:

- **Opening Hours:** 5:00 AM – 9:00 PM
- **Address:** Ratchadaphisek Rd, Khlong Toei, Bangkok
- **Dress Code:** No strict dress code, but wear something light and comfortable—it can get quite hot!

How to get there:

Take BTS to Asoke Station. The park is walking distance from here.

Pathumwananurak Park is a hidden gem in the heart of Bangkok, offering a peaceful escape with its open green spaces and modern design. It's a great spot to unwind, take a stroll, or simply enjoy a quiet moment in the middle of the city.

Here's what you need to know:

- **Opening Hours:** 5:00 AM – 9:00 PM
- **Address:** Rama I Rd, Pathum Wan, Bangkok (near CentralWorld and Platinum Mall)
- **Dress Code:** No strict dress code, but light, comfortable clothing is ideal for the warm weather.

How to get there:

Take BTS to Chit Lom Station. The park is walking distance from here.

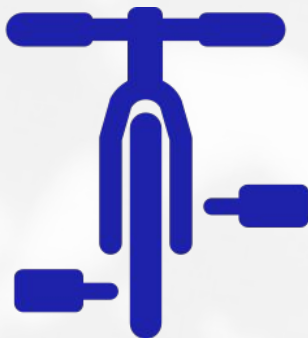
